**Notes:** Arrived in the Deliverance in May, 1610. Living @ Sherley hundred, Charles Cittie in 1624/5 -age 35. 1 house. Living in the household of Roger Bagwell in Muster of 1624/5 He served in the House of Burgesses from Accawmack, 1630/32

William Bagwell was a prosperous London merchant, circa 1650.

By the mid-17th century the Bagwell family was located in Northampton County, Virginia. Elizabeth Bagwell, daughter of Thomas Bagwell, married William Tilney, baptised 1661, Northampton County, son of John and Ann Tilney. Their children: William Tilney, married Elizabeth ?, Comfort Tilney who was of age in 1707, married William Warrington, Patience Tilney married Benjamin Stockley, Elizabeth Tilney, married John Chambers.

Henery Bagwell was christened the 29 October, 1589 at St. Petrock, Exeter, Devonshire, the son of David Bagwell. The Bagwell family were merchants and involved in London trade. Henery arrived in Virginia in the ship Deliverance in May of 1610. In the Musters of 1624/5 he is listed as living at Sherely Hundred, Charles City, when his age is given as 35. He married Alice Stratton Chilcott sometime in 1636/7 and their children were John, Thomas and Rebecca and a stepson, Thomas Stratton. By the mid 17th century the Bagwell family had located in Northampton County, Virginia. Henery Bagwell died by 1662. His death place is unknown. His granddaughter, Elizabeth Bagwell, daughter of his son, Thomas, married William Tilney, c. 1661 in Northampton County, the son of John and Ann Tilney of Northampton County. Elizabeth and William Tilney's children were William, Comfort, Patience and Elizabeth.

Robert Bagwell is listed in the Muster of 1624/5 at West and Sherley Hundred.
